



Introduction:

Mumbai Roti Bank is a hunger relief, non-profit organisation bearing registration number E-34021(M) registered on 26th April 2018 under Mumbai Sarvajanik Trust Act 1950. We provide freshly cooked mid-day meals to see that children go to school regularly. We serve freshly cooked meals outside hospitals, destitute homes, educational institutions, cancer centres, in the slums of Mumbai and various other locations. Our mission is no one should go hungry.

Mumbai Roti Bank was initiated by former Director General of Police, Maharashtra, Mr. D. Sivanandhan in December 2017, with a mission “to rescue excess food from those who have and give to the hungry who do not have”. Our aim is to minimise food wastage, malnutrition and eliminate hunger.

Amidst the alarming situation in the country due to outbreak of COVID-19 (Novel Corona virus) and due to lockdown, many labourers and daily wage workers have lost their livelihood. We distributed meals at 40+ locations across the city to those in need in the month of April and May. We were serving up to 35,000+ freshly cooked meals to underprivileged children and migrant workers during initial phases of the pandemic.

Since the inception, Mumbai Roti Bank has served more than **9.7 million+** meals. During the first two years, we have served more than 1 million meals. We have initiated Roti Bank in Nagpur, Hyderabad, Coimbatore, Chennai, Ahmedabad and Cuttack.

We have served **8,195,830+** meals in Mumbai and suburbs covering areas with high migrant and daily-wager populations as of now. We have served **6,78,650+** meals and daily wage workers in Nagpur. We also provided footwears to migrants in Nagpur who walked miles to reach their hometowns. We have served **2,90,350+** meals in **Hyderabad**, **2,18,500+** meals in **Coimbatore**, **1,83,132+** meals in **Chennai**, **94,850+** meals in **Ahmedabad** and **53,750+** meals in **Cuttack**. We are aiming to serve maximum people in these difficult times.

Objective:

To support Mumbai Roti Bank for purchase of Maruti Suzuki Supercarry Delivery Van which will be used for the distribution of meals across Mumbai.
